**Subject: Judgment of Madame Justice S. Korn of Vienna  
Concerning Mr. Chang Ung (IOC member)  
and the International Taekwon-Do Federation (ITF)  
Your Reference No. CDK/2003/slo1724**

I am pleased to inform you that the question of who are the officers of the International Taekwon-Do Federation has been resolved by the courts in Austria, where the ITF is legally registered.

In a judgment handed down on October 27th 2005, Madame Justice Susanne Korn of the Provincial Court for Civil Law Matters in Vienna ascertained that the officers of the ITF, after July 26, 2004, are:

President	Trần Triều Quân
Vice-President	Pablo Trajtenberg
Secretary	Thomas MacCallum
Treasurer	Wim Bos

Judge Korn ruled that the change in the legal registry of clubs and associations carried out as a result of false representations by Mr. Chang Ung and his supporters in the summer of 2004 is null and void, and all measures taken by Mr. Chang Ung's group and all the resolutions passed at a meeting they purported to have held on July 26, 2004. A subsequent objection to this judgment was filed by Mr. Chang Ung and rejected by the court.

This court decision confirms our assertion that Mr. Chang Ung and his supporters never were officers of the ITF and never had any right to act for the ITF.

Justice Korn also ordered Mr. Chang Ung to pay the costs of the proceedings.
